Starting Date: Saturday, September 20, 2024 from 10 am – 1 pm

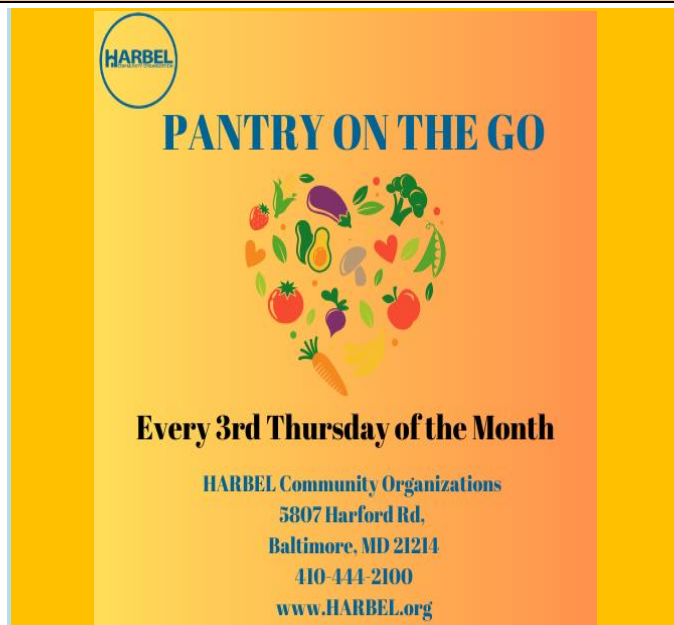
